



# **MAT INFORMATION**

## MAT TESTING INFORMATION

1. The Miller Analogies Test (MAT) is offered at MSU in both computer based and paper-and-pencil versions. Computerized MAT testing may be scheduled Monday through Friday at 9:00AM, 10:00AM, 11:00AM, 12:00PM, 1:00PM, or 2:00 PM. The paper-and-pencil version of the MAT is administered each month according to the dates provided in the attached schedule.
2. To pre-register for both types, a student will need to complete the MAT registration form and present a check or money order payable to Mountain State University for \$15.00. The student then must contact the Testing Center in person or by calling (304) 929-1333 or 800-766-6067 ext. 1333, to secure a seat at least 24 hours in advance of the desired test date.
3. On the day of the examination, each tester will need to present a check or money order made payable to Mountain State University for the test fee of **\$55**. Payment by credit card is also accepted.

**NOTE:** Due to seats being limited and reserved ahead of time, testers will be responsible for missed or canceled examination dates. Any tester who misses or cancels their examination date will **STILL** be responsible for the \$15.00 owed to Mountain State University for the seat reserved. **NO EXCEPTIONS!!!**

4. All students **must** present 2 forms of identification including a valid state or school issued photo ID on the day of testing.
5. A full description of MAT policies and other important information can be found in the Candidate Information Booklet to which this pamphlet is attached. Please read this brochure in full prior to scheduling.
5. Students **are not** allowed to bring any items to the testing session such as a calculator, paper, book, periodic table, pagers, cell phones, notes, cameras, recording devices of any kind, or reference materials of any kind.
6. Students will be sent a personal Score Report, a Transcript Request Form for additional Official Transcripts, and a Retest Admission Ticket that must be used in order to gain admittance to retake the MAT. Colleges and universities will receive an official score report within 2 weeks of the test date.
